#### Dương Quang Thiên (2006)

Vietnamese-American ranked 4th in the world (PPA). Winner of IHG Briston Open 2024 and Open Pickleball Championship in Vietnam.



#### Huỳnh Thiên Phúc (2000)

Asia's No. 1 player. Gold medalist at AOPC 2024 and Men's Singles Champion in Australia.



#### Trinh Linh Giang (1997)

Ranked 25th in the world and 6th in Asia.



#### Trương Vinh Hiến (2004)

Ranked 57th globally and 7th in Asia.

By mid-2024, Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City each had over 200 pickleball courts.

Lào Cai expanded rapidly with 400 courts and 100 clubs within 9 months.

Pickleball products sold on five major e-commerce Platforms reached 22.7 billion VND (£725,000), a 150% increase from the previous quarter. 

Approx. 1.5-3 million VND (£48-£96) for basic equipment (paddle; balls, shoes) and trial play. FOR RECULAR PLANERS Approx. 3–8 million VND (£96–£257) for higher-quality

equipment and tournament participation.
