2022

2024

Riyadh hosted the Saudi Arabia Snooker Masters twice, in March and December, featuring top players and live streaming on DAZN to increase accessibility.

2025

Morocco hosted the World Snooker Championship in Saidia (Jan 24-Feb 1), the first time this event was held in Africa.
